Halfway There

Construction Begins on Second Wing of Haitian School



It's hard to believe that seven short months ago ground breaking took place for a new elementary school in Desarmes, Haiti. Finishing touches are being put on the small administrative building and first wing of this school, where 4 of the 8 classrooms are located. It won't be long, and students will be moving from their current makeshift classrooms to this completed wing.

Construction has just started on the second wing, where 4 additional classrooms will be located. We anticipate the entire school will be completed by early summer of 2017, making it possible for the nearly 300 students to be educated in a permanent structure for the 2017-18 school year.

Home Sweet Home

Imagine raising 4 children in the home pictured right. Imagine food preparation, lack of sanitation, and issues of safety. It's hard to fathom, but millions of people live in similar and worse conditions in the country of Haiti; a country 700 miles from Miami, Florida. Part of our mission at CWI is to make a significant impact on the lives of the neglected. When we met Saintemene (the woman pictured above), in the summer of 2015, we were convicted by her story and her circumstances, and inspired to make an impact for her and her children.



Through contacts in Haiti, we were able to obtain a legal i.d. card for Saintemene, something she had never had. With legal proof of identification, Saintemene was able to become a legal land owner, so we purchased a small plot of land in her name, where we planned to build a home for her and her four children.

We're happy to report that this home is almost completed. The house includes a kitchen, a bathroom complete with sink, toilet, and shower area, a large living area, and 3 bedrooms. In addition, specific donations were given so that local craftsmen could build a bed for each family member, a dresser for clothes storage, and a dining table with chairs so the family can eat together.
